# Do you work with plant and would like to be able to diagnose and respond to basic faults?

#### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

When you are working with plant, be it small or large, you will be required to identify and report faults in accordance with site procedures.

This course will develop your knowledge and skills in operational maintenance for the Resources and Infrastructure sectors, by taking you through common mechanical and electrical faults that could occur. You will learn to not only identify common basic faults, but also how to respond to them.

#### **COURSE DURATION**

This course is two (2) days.

#### **DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT**

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

### **COURSE OUTCOME**

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Plan and prepare for applying operational maintenance skills
- Identify and respond to basic faults in mechanical systems
- Identify and respond to basic faults in electrical systems
- Identify, select and use fasteners
- Conduct housekeeping activities

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment.
