

EWP BELOW 11M SCISSOR AND BOOM LIFT (EWPA YELLOW CARD)

RIIHAN301E - Operate elevating work platform

Are you in a workplace where you will need to operate a scissor and/or boom lift, but not go above 11m?

COURSE OVERVIEW

EWPs are powered mobile plant designed to lift or lower people and equipment to a work location, by means of a telescoping device or articulated device, beyond a base support.

This course trains and assesses in the operation of a scissor type lift (unrestricted height) and boom lift (below 11m height).

The 'Yellow Card' means the training is endorsed by the Elevating Work Platform Association (EWPA).

This course satisfies the <u>SafeWork SA minimum</u> <u>training requirements</u> expected for workers who operate EWPs in accordance with the person conducting a business or undertaking's (PCBU) primary duty of care under the Work Health and Safety Act 2012.

COURSE OUTCOME

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Plan and prepare for operating an elevating work platform
- Conduct work activities from elevating work platform
- Carry out operator maintenance
- Clean up

If successful, you will receive a Statement of Attainment and an EWPA Yellow Card for Scissor lift and/or boom below 11m class.

DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory, practical training and assessment components to the course.

In theory assessment component you will be required to complete a written assessment unassisted (closed book assessment).

- The required outcome of this assessment is 100% and conducted in two steps pending upon the result of step 1.
- Step 1 is a **closed book assessment** with an outcome of 22/27 or greater.
- If 27/27 is achieved in Step 1, there is no requirement to progress to Step 2.
- If 22/27 is not achieved, you will not pass the theory component and will have to undergo another training day before you can proceed to practical assessment.

COURSE DURATION

This course is one (1) day.

LOCATION

Public courses are scheduled frequently in Adelaide at our facility at 14-16 Tilalara St, Regency Park.

This course can also be delivered regionally – please contact the office for regional locations and dates.



PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Enclosed, safety footwear, long pants and long-sleeved shirts with hi-vis are required. Other sites may have other requirements which will be confirmed at the time of booking. Failure to wear correct PPE may prevent the participant from completing the practical training and/or assessment.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

ALL LEARNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION UPON ARRIVING FOR THEIR COURSE.

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course.

The applicant must be able to use the English language at a level that is appropriate for the safe use and operation of the particular class of equipment, including:

- using a range of communication techniques and equipment to coordinate activities with others
- maintaining written and verbal reporting requirements and procedures

Learners will need to able to work at height.

You must be 17 years or older to undertake this course. If you are under 17 years old, ask to speak to a representative.
