Are you involved in the using levelling equipment? Are you working as a Laser Safety Officer?

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course will provide the training to become a Laser Safety Officer (LSO) for current or aspiring supervisors in the civil or construction industries.

Learn to use the correct laser for the job and comply with the recommendations of current Australian general laser safety standards (AS/NZ IEC 60825) and industry specific standards such as AS 2397 – Safe use of lasers in the building and construction industry.

- Biological effects (skin / eye)
- Aversion effects
