MSMWHS216 – Operate breathing apparatus

Are you required to use breathing apparatus because you are working in irrespirable atmospheres?

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course covers the skills and knowledge required to operate and maintain breathing apparatus and equipment in an irrespirable atmosphere, as defined by the Australian Standard AS/NZS 1715:2009 Selection, use and maintenance of respiratory protective equipment.

COURSE DURATION

This course is one (1) day.

COURSE OUTCOME

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Conduct pre-donning checks and tests on breathing apparatus
- Operate breathing apparatus
- Conclude operations in accordance with procedures

If successful you will receive a Statement of Attainment.

Industry recommends that refresher courses are undertaken every two years.

DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

LOCATION

Public courses are scheduled frequently in Adelaide and Alice Springs.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Enclosed, safety footwear, long pants and long-sleeved shirts with hi-vis are required. Other sites may have other requirements which will be confirmed at the time of booking. Failure to wear correct PPE may prevent the participant from completing the practical training and/or assessment.



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

ALL LEARNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION UPON ARRIVING FOR THEIR COURSE.

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course.

Civil Train recommends year 10 school completion or equivalent as a guide to the level required for short courses.

Language. Literacy and Numeracy skills required for this course include:

- identify hazards and apply control measures according to procedures
- communicate while using breathing apparatus
- determine the available working time from a breathing apparatus set
- report faults and/or damage to breathing apparatus

You must be **clean shaven** to undertake the breathing apparatus assessment.
