

# BASIC WORKSITE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT (BWTM) and TRAFFIC CONTROLLER (TC) REFRESHER

Update your Main Roads WA issued Basic Worksite Traffic Management (BWTM) and Traffic Controller (TC) licence before the three-year expiry!

### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

This refresher course is the re-accreditation required every three years by Main Roads WA for Basic Worksite Traffic Management (BWTM) and Traffic Control (TC). Participants will be updated with the latest information and changes to implementing traffic management and controlling traffic on WA roads.

Civil Train Western Australia is a Main Roads WA approved training provider.

# **COURSE DURATION**

This course is 1days (8hours).

# **COURSE OUTCOME**

Upon successful completion of this course participants will be re-issued with a new Main Roads WA accreditation and ID card.

# PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Long pants and a long-sleeved shirt, safety boots and hi-vis is required for the practical component of this course. Other sites may have other requirements which will be confirmed at the time of booking. Failure to wear correct PPE may prevent the participant from completing the practical training and/or assessment.



# **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

### ALL LEARNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION UPON ARRIVING FOR THEIR COURSE.

Participants will need to meet the following to qualify for the refresher course.

- Hold the WorkSafe Construction Safety Awareness Card (White or Blue card)
- Currently hold or previously held a WA drivers' licence (must provide evidence of this)
- Provide a current MRWA accreditation for BWTM & TC (or be within the 3 month grace period of expiry).
- Must be able to provide evidence of active engagement in industry within the previous 12 months. This may include
  written evidence from employer/s or client references.

Entrants will need a level of language and literacy skills to enable them to meet the requirements of the course. Civil Train recommends year 10 school completion or equivalent as a guide to the level required for short courses.
