WORKING AT HEIGHTS

RIIWHS204E - Work safely at heights

COURSE OVERVIEW

'Working at height' is whenever people are at risk of falling from, into or through one level to another or at risk of hitting others below with falling objects.

When working at height, preparation and planning are essential. Falls from height can leave employees with permanent and debilitating injuries. Falls often occur from roofs, scaffolds, ladders, trucks and mazzanine floors or into pits or holes, although falls from less than one metre can result in serious injury.

COURSE DURATION

This course is one day.

DELIVERY & ASSESSMENT

This course is delivered and assessed face to face.

There are theory and practical training and assessment components to the course.

LOCATION

Public courses are scheduled frequently in Adelaide, Perth and Alice Springs.
